ABOUT THE GRANT AND THE TRAINING

What is covered :

- Subscription and training fees for 3 weeks
- Round-trip train ticket from Paris to the Provinces
- Part of the costs for lodging and food

The grant does not cover the airfare USA/France.

Dates : **July, 7 to July, 25, 2008** (3 weeks)

Destinations offered :

Please note that the Embassy might not be able to allocate the candidate's first choice.

Candidate selected by the cultural services and AATF :

- Strasbourg, (about 70 hours of training)
- Grenoble, (about 60 hours of training)
- Paris, (about 70 hours of training)

Theme : Intensive study of French language, teaching French and modern French culture through writing, theatre, the movies...

ELIGIBILITY (SPCD)

Full-time teachers in accredited schools who :

- are US Citizen or Permanent Resident (French citizens are not allowed to apply)
- have working knowledge of French
- are assigned to teach the French language and/or French Culture in grades K-12
- wish to strengthen their French language skills and enhance their knowledge of French culture
- have not received a grant from the French Government for the last 3 years
